WHAT IS A VEHICLE CROSSING?

A vehicle crossing is the area of driveway between a public road and the private property boundary.

DO I NEED PERMISSION?

If you want to build, modify or repair a vehicle crossing, you must get written approval from Auckland Transport before you start work.

We can take care of this from application to sign off.

WHAT WORK WILL NEED TO BE DONE?

The work will vary but here is list of works often required to complete an AT crossing.

- Site preparation (Excavation)
- Concrete (Laying base course, compacting, laying concrete)
- Drainage (Laying pipes/culverts)
- Traffic Management
- Optional work may include (Fencing, gates, cattle stop)

CAN I CHOOSE WHERE IT GOES AND WHAT IT LOOKS LIKE?

There are engineering standards which relate to the physical construction of vehicle crossings and their location, these are dictated by Auckland Transport.

We can take care of this from application to sign off.

HOW MUCH WILL IT COST?

You will need to arrange a quote to get an accurate picture of the final cost but do consider that the wider the crossing is, the more materials will be required which impacts the final cost.
