Water Storage





HOW CAN I INCREASE MY WATER STORAGE?

To choose the right water storage option you should consider what your needs are. Do you need household drinking water or water for gardens or stock. Are you supplementing your existing supply, replacing an old system or starting from scratch?

WHAT ARE MY OPTIONS?

Concrete tanks are durable and come in a variety of high capacity sizes. They can be painted a desired colour or fully buried in the ground. If you do not want your tanks visible near the house these are your best option.

Plastic Tanks are durable and come in a wide variety of sizes 1000 - 30,000L and a range of colours. They are simple to install, can be partially buried (up to 1m) and are lower cost than concrete.

Ponds and dams are a great option for collecting water for gardens and stock. They can be very high capacity but are vulnerable to evaporation. They can also create a beautiful feature on your property.

CAN I CHOOSE WHERE THEY GO?

Yes, but it wise to consider gravity (If your tank is above the house you will have to pump water to it.) Ponds should be located where the land formation will funnel water in naturally. We can advise you on the best location for your tanks or ponds.

WHAT WORK WILL NEED TO BE DONE?

It varies depending on the job, but here is list of works often required to install a tank or create a pond.

- Tanks Excavation (either a level pad or a hole if fully burying)
- Ponds and dams Excavation, pipes and gabion (for flood control and erosion)
